



GENERAL INFORMATION

- All targets will be registered with the ATA, except the Butte Medal, and shooters must be ATA members. Annual membership payable upon registration.
- ATA and MSTA fees apply to each day's program or event. ATA rules govern all events. By entering an event, shooters agree to abide by all ATA rules and to accept all official decisions.
- All ties for Singles and Doubles trophies will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap ties will be handled in accordance with ATA Rules. Failure to be present for an announced shoot-off will result in forfeit. Money will be divided in case of ties, except the Butte Medal.
- Ties will be shot off in the following manner: Singles-25 targets, 16-yard; Handicap-25 targets; Doubles-10pairs; All-Around-20 Singles, 10 Handicap, & 5 Pair Doubles.
- Please be ready when your squad number is posted on the starting board.
- Hand loads permitted, subject to ATA rules.
- If you want your empty cases, please catch them before they hit the ground.
- Watch your scores. They cannot be changed after you leave the shooting post.
- Errors in scores must be corrected on the score sheets before you change stations. The management will refuse to enter into discussion on this point and will compile the scores as shown on the score sheets.
- Grievances will be handled by the MSTA Grievance Committee.
- This is an Invitational Tournament, and the management reserves the authority to reject, refund, or disqualify any contestant who interferes with the conduct, accuracy, or sportsmanship of the Shoot. Likewise, the management may exercise the right to change or modify this program in whole or in part.
- THERE WILL BE NO WITHDRAWAL OF OPTION OR PURSE MONIES AFTER AN EVENT HAS STARTED.
- On Singles and Handicap, only the "Lost" targets will be called. In Doubles, the results on both targets will be called.
- Practice traps will be available each day. See each day's schedule for times.
- The Billings Trap Club will not be responsible for any accident or for loss of property.
- To win the H.R. "Firecracker" Peterson 100 straight pin, you must break 100 targets in one of the three championship events (Doubles, Singles, Handicap), no carry-overs. If you qualify, see Susan or Rick Dorr.
- Cashiers will accept cash, checks, and credit/debit cards for entry fees. All fees must be paid in U.S. funds. A 3% surcharge will be applied for credit card transactions.
- White Flyer targets will be thrown and Pat-traps & Canterbury voice calls will be used on all fields.





MSTA STANDARD PROCEDURES

PENALTY YARDAGE AND CLASSIFICATION:

The handicap committee must assign a minimum of 24 yards, Class A Singles and Class A Doubles to any shooter who does not have 500 Singles, 500 Handicap, and 500 Doubles in the current and previous year combined. Juniors and Sub-Juniors are exempt from the yardage penalty only, effective 2025 as revised by the Board at the 2024 Directors meeting.

CLASS WINNERS:

Beginning with Thursday Class Doubles, the winner and ties in and out of state of any Class Event advances to the next highest class for the remainder of the shoot. The shooter must advise the cashier of such changes for options and purse calculations. At the 1999 Board Meeting, the Board voted to award pins to the Class winners in the State Doubles on Friday and the State Singles event 200 birds on Saturday and Sunday.

YARDAGE WINNERS:

Any shooter that earns yardage, in any Handicap events, must shoot the next event from his or her new yardage or forfeit any and all prizes. The shooter is responsible to have his or her card punched and advise the cashier of yardage changes for options and purse calculations.

ALL-STATE TEAM:

Shooters must have at least 1500 Singles, 1500 Handicap, and 1000 Doubles to qualify. The same applies to Veterans, Ladies, Juniors, Sr. Vet, and Sub Jr. If a category shooter makes the All-State Team, they must vacate the special category award allowing the next high shooter in the special category to move up. In the event no one in a special category qualifies, with the required targets, a winner may be chosen based on a combined average of Singles and Handicap targets. The number of targets registered will also have a strong bearing on the selection. The above targets requirements were revised by the Board at the 1998 Directors Meeting. Sr. Vet & Sub Jr. were added at the July 2001 Directors Meeting.

HI-AVERAGE AWARDS:

To qualify for a Montana State Hi-Average Award, a shooter must have either 1500 Singles or 1500 Handicap or 1000 Doubles. To qualify for the Over-All Award, shooters must have at least 1500 Singles, 1500 Handicap, and 1000 Doubles.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS EVENT:

Will be shot on the first half of the State Singles Championship. Open only to Montana shooters that are members of paid-up MSTA member clubs. Each club selects their champion who is then eligible to compete. Each club champion must pay a \$1.00 entry fee and place his or her name on the list provided. There will be a trophy and \$50.00 awarded to the winner. Ties shoot-off for both trophy & money. Shoot-offs are carried over to the 2nd half of Singles Championship via 25's. If a tie exists, reverse score on 25's will be used. If still undecided, there will then be a head-to-head shoot-off.

BIRTHDAYS:

ATA rules will apply.

STATE SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP:

State Singles Championship will be decided on 200 targets, Events 10 & 13. The MSTA will provide funds to the State Champion or a Runner-Up, provided he or she agrees to enter the Champion of Champions race at the Grand American if eligible. ATA RULES allow only the State Champion or Runner-Up to enter the Champion of Champions event.

IN ALL CASES:

The recipients of these monies must enter the Champion of Champions event at the Grand American to receive this expense money from the MSTA. The winner is to notify the MSTA secretary as soon as possible whether they will or will not be able to attend the Grand. If the Champion or Runner-up does not attend the Grand, the day fees are retained in the MSTA treasury and awarded at the following years state shoot in the following manner. The money is to be rounded down to the nearest \$500.00 and awarded as added money to the High All Around winners by Class (AA, A, B, C, D) high gun 50-30-20; closed to out of state shooters.

SPECIAL CATEGORY TROPHIES:

All shooters eligible to shoot for Special Trophies must place their names on the lists provided at the bulletin board.

DECLARE SPECIAL CATEGORIES:

All Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-Juniors, Juniors, Junior Golds, Sub-Veterans, Veterans, Senior Veterans, and Chair Shooters must declare their special category at the time of their entry. Without such declaration at the time of entry, the shooter will not be allowed to compete for the applicable special category trophies. No exceptions to this rule are to be allowed.

TRAP AND FIELD:

MSTA will give Champions and Runner-Ups in State All Around, Singles, Doubles, and Handicap Championship Events a one-year subscription to Trap and Field. The winners must contact the MSTA Secretary.

REFUNDS:

No entry fees, purses, or options will be refunded after the event has started. All refunds will be mailed to the shooter with the payoff. NO CASH REFUNDS.

RESIDENT:

He or she must have met the legal and ATA requirements for citizenship in the State of Montana. He/she may not have participated in the State shoot for any other state, representing himself/herself as a resident of that state and eligible for state shooting titles of that state, within the calendar year of the last preceding Montana State Trapshooting Association's last State Trapshoot. If he/she is desirous of transferring his membership from any other state to Montana and becoming a member of this Association, he/she shall inform the MSTA of his/her intentions at least six months prior to any Montana State Shoot to be eligible to participate in same. A shooter without a permanent ATA card shall be required to qualify his/her residency with the MSTA delegate or the handicap committee.

PRE-REGISTRATION

 You can squad in advance at SOSClays.com or use the form at the end of this program. If mailing, the form must be received by July 1, 2025 and MUST include a \$25.00 nonrefundable deposit that will be applied to entry fees. Please make checks payable to BTC (Billings Trap Club) and mail to:

- These are the only two methods that will be used for pre-squadding. NO phone calls will be accepted. Partial or full squads are accepted but please mail in the same envelope.
- Management is not responsible for entries that are received late.

SQUADDING

- Contestants are requested to enter all contemplated events at initial sign-in. Money will be refunded on any uncontested event provided you notify the cashier of your intention to withdraw before the event starts.
- We hope to hold the number of short squads to a minimum. If you miss your squad, a \$10.00 charge will be made to be re-squadded. If the weather is bad and you miss your squad, you will not be allowed to re-enter if the weather improves.

SQUAD HUSTLING

In order to keep disturbance of shooters on the firing line to a minimum, we will not call each squad on the PA system. The numbers of squads and their starting order will be posted on the starting board. There will be no waiting. Your cooperation and attention are necessary to make sure shooting runs smoothly. We will be shooting 25 targets per trap and starting three squads at the beginning of each event.

ADDED MONEY

A total of \$16,500 added money is open to all shooters. This is divided among several events as listed in the program. No special entry fee is required to participate. This money is provided by:

HIGH GUN PAYOFFS

The number of pays in a High Gun Payoff is determined by how many shooters enter the event. In the Montana State Shoot, one place will be paid for each quantity filled and a place for any fraction thereof. In a 1-in-7 event, one place is paid for each seven entries and one more place is paid if there are any remaining entries. For example: 21 entries pay three places, 22 entries pay four places. Four places are paid until there are 29 entries.

Registration Certificate

GENERAL MEETING OF THE MSTA

The General Meeting of the MSTA will be held Friday, July 11th at 8:00 AM at the Billings Trap Club Pavilion prior to Event 7. The purpose of this meeting is to transact any business to come before the Association, elect MSTA Officers, Board of Directors, A.T.A. Delegate, A.T.A. Alternate, and select a host club for the 2027 State Shoot.

BUTTE ROD & GUN CLUB MEDAL

The Butte Rod & Gun Club Medal is a non-registered 40 target event (15 @ 20 Yds, 15 @ 22 Yds, 5 pair doubles).

*Only Montana shooters are eligible to win the medal and the \$100 added money. **Added money will be divided into 10 Lewis classes. There will be no ties. Ties broken by: 1) Long run from the front; 2) Long run from the back; 3) Coin flip. The top class added money will go to the Medal Winner. Each class is worth \$200. The money division has to be done manually by the Host Club. This Added Money is open to all participants, as is the Purse option.

****SPECIAL EVENT PARTY****

SATURDAY THE 12TH IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING SHOOTOFFS

- Special Event entries close at 3:00 pm Saturday. Special Event payoff is High Gun System paying 1 place per 10 entries with 70% for the buyer and 30% for the shooter limited to 20 places.
- The Special Event auction will be held Saturday evening, July 12th, 2025. The Billings Trap Club will host a cocktail party prior to the auction at the Pavilion with mixed drinks, beer, and hors d'oeuvres.

TRAPSHOOTING HALL OF FAME OPTION & CONTRIBUTOR AWARD

One half of the \$20 entry fee for this option is a tax-deductible donation to the Trapshooting Hall of Fame. This donation provides support to our museum and to the many projects undertaken by the Hall of Fame. Your entry slip shows this contribution and is your receipt. One half of the entry fee for this option will be forwarded to the Trapshooting Hall of Fame, and the other half will be paid out in three Lewis Classes, 60/40 high gun each class. The high participating shooter will receive a specially crafted oak plaque with a historic photo. All participants will qualify for this beautiful Hall of Fame Award. Ties will be resolved by shoot management. Hall of Fame is recognized as a 501(c)3 charitable organization by the IRS.



2025 Hall of Fame Inductee Andrew Kelly

In the mid-1980s Andrew Kelly began shooting competition archery and over the course of 20+ years was well-known as a multi-sponsored distinguished Master Archer with numerous IBO Western Triple Crown and ASA Champion titles, Canadian National Indoor/Outdoor 3D Championships (among others) and finishing 6th at the IBO World Championships. In 2003, coming off his final IBO Western Triple Crown win, Andrew left the competitive world of archery and a chance at the Olympics. In 2004, after years of prodding from the late great MSTA Hall of Fame inductee, Mr. Scotty Levengood, Andrew joined a winter league team and shot his first registered target in March. He made MSTA 1st Team in 2005, quickly advanced to the back fence by 2006, followed by Montana State Singles Champion and Browning Class Doubles (3rd) at the Grand American, along with AA27AA status, in 2008. He holds a 97.12% average on

39,000 registered singles targets (over 112,000 registered career targets).

Andrew has held a seat on the Board of Directors at the Flathead Valley Clay Target Club since 2004 and has selflessly dedicated numerous volunteer hours to the betterment of the club, the sport, and to the success of others. He has actively participated in the Montana State Team Singles shoot consistently since 2016, encouraging growth in the ATA and successfully leading a dual team win for Team Singles and Team Handicap in 2022 – the first documented simultaneous wins at the same tournament. The Butte Medal displays three wins for Andrew (2007, 2012, 2018) - the 27 yard doubles criteria was adopted in 2006 to end a shoot-off after three rounds of 40 targets – with a chuckle, Andrew has always declared that with this first attempt at 27 yard doubles, he was schooled by the MSTA Hall of Fame Inductee, Mr. Bruce Wagner, to whom he has great respect. In 2015, he earned MT State All-Around Champion, in 2023 received the MT State Doubles Champion title, and numerous others including the Western Zone, neighboring state shoots titles, MSTA State Team appearances, MT State Championships, and FVCTC AAA Winter League Team Championships – one of the original members dubbed in fun as "the God Squad".

In 2019, Andrew began coaching the 406 Clay Target Youth Team with infusion of positive criticism, wisdom, sustainable vision for success, teachable moments that become knowledge, and navigating resilience in the face of adversity. His "lead by example approach" has instilled ownership of action, unwavering sportsmanship, and humility as qualities in the making of champions. Coaching Team406 has been noted by him to be his proudest contribution and ultimate opportunity to give back to the sport that has given so much to him.
